**Notification under section 57(2) of application of Chapter X
to certain places of employment**

LABOUR (SPECIAL PLACES OF EMPLOYMENT) NOTIFICATION

Commencement: 1st January 1956

Citation.

1. This notification may be cited as the Labour (Special Places of Employment) Notification.

Application.

2. The provisions of sections 58 to 63 and 67 to 69 (all sections inclusive) of the Labour Act shall apply to all places of employment where an industrial undertaking is carried on in which the average number of workers employed per day is not less than 25; and, in addition, the provisions of section 59 of that Act shall apply to all places of employment in which any manual worker (other than a domestic servant) is employed.
