STATUTORY DECLARATIONS ACT

An Act to make provision concerning statutory declarations 1 of 1951
(Cap. 12 of 1951)
S.99/59

Commencement: 11th January 1951

1. This Act may be cited as the Statutory Declarations Act. Short title

2. It shall be lawful for any magistrate, or any officer authorized by His Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan, to take and receive in Brunei the declaration of any person voluntarily making the same in the form in the Schedule. Declarations made in Brunei

3. Declarations made in Brunei by virtue of the provisions of this Act shall be deemed to be such declarations as are referred to in sections 199 and 200 of the Penal Code. False declarations punishable under Penal Code (Cap. 22)

4. A person making any declaration by virtue of the provisions of this Act shall pay to the officer taking the same such fees as His Majesty in Council may from time to time by public notification prescribe. Fees
