PUBLIC ENTERTAINMENT (EXEMPTION) ORDER

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as the Public Entertainment (Exemption) Order.

Exempted public entertainment.

2. The following classes of public entertainments are hereby exempted from the provisions of the Public Entertainment Act —

(a) any public entertainment held in a school, college or other learning institution for the benefit of the students and their parents which is of an educational or like character; and

(b) any non-commercial exhibition arranged by a professional body, organisation or similar institution to promote its activities.
