# LEGAL PROFESSION (PRACTISING CERTIFICATE) RULES

Commencement: 1st January 1987

### Citation.

1. These Rules may be cited as the Legal Profession (Practising Certificate) Rules.

#### Petition for Admission Form 1.

**2.** A petition for admission under section 5 of the Act shall be in Form I in the First Schedule to these Rules.

#### Form 2 and Form 3.

**3.** The certificates required under section 5(3) of the Act shall be in Form 2 and Form 3 in the First Schedule to these Rules.

### Application for practising certificate Form 4.

4. An application for a practising certificate under section 13 of the Act shall be in Form 4 contained in the First Schedule to these Rules.

### **Declaration Form 5.**

5. An application for a practising certificate shall be accompained by a declaration in writing in Form 5 contained in the First Schedule to these Rules.

### Form of practising certificate.

6. A practising certificate shall be in Form 6 in the First Schedule to these Rules.

#### Fees Second Schedule.

7. The fees set out in the Second Schedule shall be payable in relation to the matters specified therein.

### FORM 1
